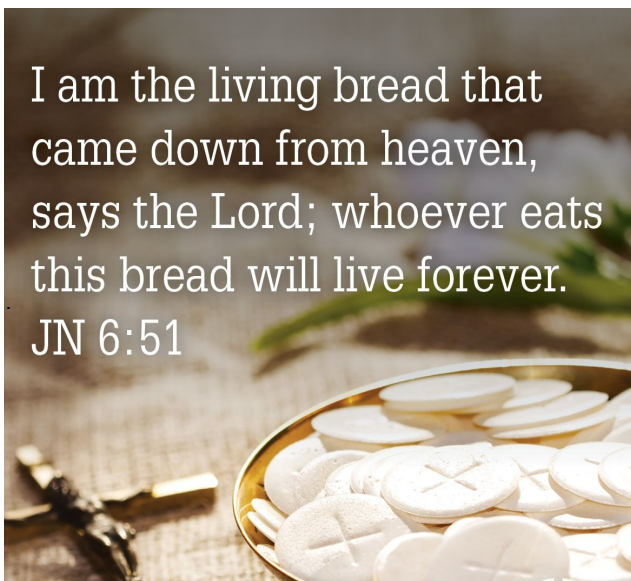

Consecrating our Country to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and joining the U.S. bishops in celebrating the 250th anniversary of our nation!

- **8:15am**—Holy Mass followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament
- **All day adoration**
- **3:00pm**—Divine Mercy Chaplet, Eucharistic procession, Litany to the Sacred Heart and consecration, Benediction

A plenary indulgence (the complete remission of temporal punishment due to sin) may be gained by confession within twenty days of the feast, communion, and praying at least an Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be for the intentions of the Holy Father. One must also renounce all attachment to sin, and be free of even venial sin.

A Catholic Phrase to Understand Better: Having a relationship with Christ

Having a relationship with Christ means having a sense of personal connection, of familiarity, with Jesus, similar to the feeling of connection we have with a spouse, a family member or a really close friend. To grow in friendship with Jesus, just ask: "Jesus, please help me to know You better. I don't want to just know about You, I want to know You." Talk to Him often during the day, tell Him your joys, your troubles, your hopes. Read slowly from one of the Gospels, meditating on the words and deeds of Jesus, asking Him to help you to see how they apply to you. Then rest in silence and listen. Do this for a few minutes each day.

Building Together Uniting Hearts and Spaces

Update as of June 2, 2026

While we are very excited to have the work started on this project, we want to make sure everyone is staying safe. Demolition is almost complete, excavations are almost done, and the ground should be flattened shortly. The foundation insulation and backfilling is next on the schedule. The underground plumbing and electrical are next. Exterior wall framing is set to start in about 4 weeks. The concrete barriers have been placed by the parking in front of church to reroute your walking path. If you need assistance, please ask for help.

The Building Committee had their second in person meeting with Ellis personnel and the sub-contractors on June 2nd. The committee was brought up to speed on the schedule for the next 6 weeks and any changes or upcoming input needed were discussed. The committee was able to review samples of finishes for both inside and out for the first time so decisions could be made when necessary down the road. The full transparency between the church members and the contractor and the subs is great. If at any time you have questions, please don't hesitate to ask one of the Building Committee. We can't wait to be Sharing Spaces with everyone!

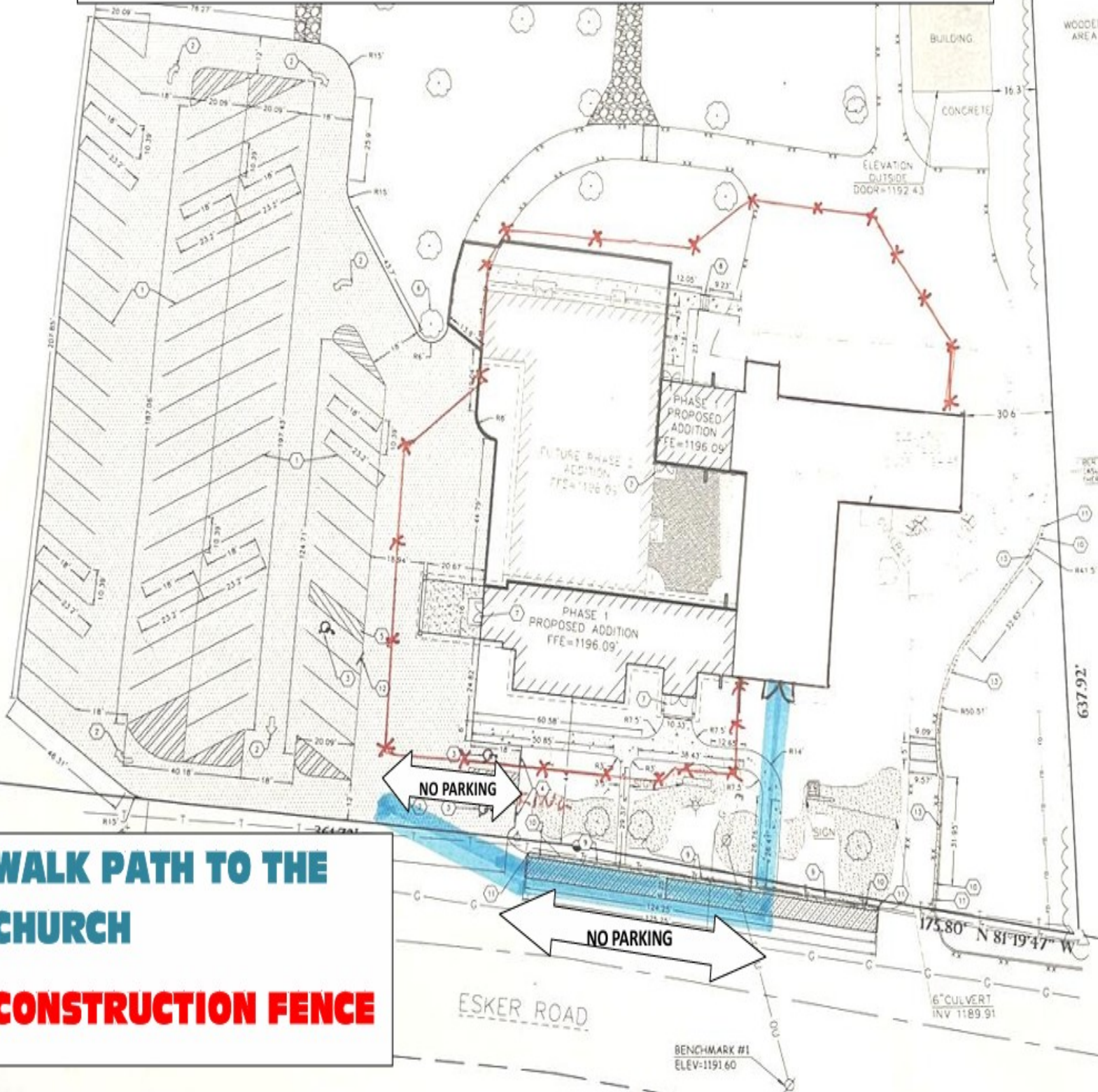
