The Building Committee met with the General Contractor, Ellis, on June 30th. As you can see, demolition is ongoing as they tie in the roof lines. The framing has started. The firewall between the church and the building will begin the week of July 7th. The roof on the sacristy will begin around July 13th. The south section is scheduled for August 3rd. Siding has been chosen. The target for completion is mid-October. Of course, weather can play a role. By the group meeting regularly, any changes can be quickly addressed.
